As readers and writers we will be...

- Learning about the events of The Great Fire of London through a variety of stimulus including diaries, fiction and non-fiction books.
- Retelling events of what happened during The Great Fire of London using a range of ambitious vocabulary.
- Writing character and setting descriptions based on a variety of stories.
- Using non-fiction books to find facts out about the past from a range of sources.
- Y1 Developing our SPAG by learning when to use exclamation marks and question marks.
- Y2 Developing our SPAG by learning when to use apostrophes and commas in a list.

As scientists we will be...

- Identifying and naming a range of materials such as wood, metal, plastic, glass, paper, fabric, rock and cardboard.
- Distinguishing between and object and a material.
- Describing the simple properties of materials. E.g. hard, soft, squashy, bendy, stiff etc.
- Working scientifically to perform simple tests on a range of materials.

Year 2

- Multiplication and division using multiples of 2, 5, 10.
- Odd and even numbers.
- Measuring length and height using cm and metres.
- Solving length and height problems using the 4 operations.

- Creating a timeline of events for The Great Fire of London.
- Looking at the similarities and differences between London now and in 1666.
- Discussing the causes and the consequences of the fire.
- Exploring the changes that took place as a result of the fire.
- Finding out about significant people from 1666—Samuel Pepys and King Charles II.
