#### We are learning to...

- ♦ Sing a wider repertoire of songs & nursery rhymes.
- Understand an instruction that has two parts; such as "Boys, get your coat and wait at red door"
- ♦ Engage in a back-and-forth conversation with an adult or a friend, and continue for several turns.
