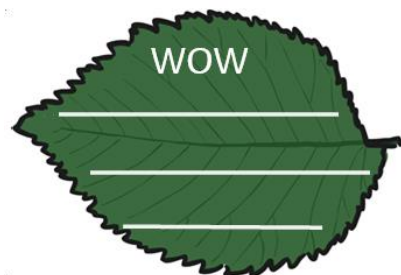
Baking biscuits

Please complete your child's Autumn 2 leaf with a recent achievement or WOW moment to add to their stem.

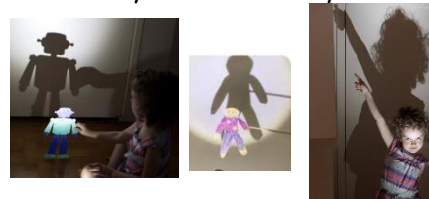
